Sub: **Online Capacity Building Program for Teachers (OCBP)**

Sir/Madam,

The State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT), Goa in collaboration with Million Sparks Foundation (MSF), Delhi will conduct **Online Capacity Building Programme** (OCBP) on the topic of **Acids, Bases and Salts** from **12/06/2019 to 21/06/2019**. Following is a brief outline of the topic with registration details.

A number of chemicals that we use on a daily basis in our houses can be acid, base or salt. This training aims at building a connect between the day to day use of these chemicals. A number of common misconceptions and their remedies have also been discussed in a separate module in the training. An effort has been made to make the topic fun and engaging in the classrooms and the teaching strategies have been discussed keeping this in mind. The training also includes worksheets for the teachers which can be used in the classroom for evaluation of students.

The **online registration** for the training on the ChalkLit app will remain open from **04-06-2019 to 11-06-2019**. You are requested to select and instruct the teachers of science subject to register online on the ChalkLit App and participate in the program. To register the teachers are required to first download the **ChalkLit** App from the Google Play or App Store (iOS - goo.gl/XUydt and Android - goo.gl/xR8wNz) on their mobile phones or login to <http://www.chalklit.in> on the computer. The teachers can refer to the ChalkLit App registration instructions in the poster attached. The ACCESS CODE for the training registration is **ABS1206**.

Teachers' progress in the training will be monitored through the in-built system in the **ChalkLit App**. Teachers who successfully complete the training will be notified about the same and will be eligible for the award of certificates. The certificate will be available online through the ChalkLit app. Teachers can use this certificate for their professional development while writing their resumes for the "Confidential Report" (C.R.).

Your encouragement to teachers in your institution to register online before the due date will be highly solicited.
