State Council of Educational Research & Training, Alto-Porvorim, Goa has scheduled the **State Level (stage I) National Talent Search Examination (NTSE) for the students of Std. Xth on 03/11/2019 (SUNDAY)** at Twelve Taluka centres viz., (1) Bicholim, (2) Bardez, (3) Pernem, (4) Sattari, (5)Tiswadi, (6)Ponda, (7) Salcete, (8)Sanguem , (9)Canacona, (10)Quepem, (11) Dharbandora and (12)Mormugao for the year 2019-2020.

Examination :The pattern of **written examination** will be as follows:

- **Stage I & II :** examination at the State/UT level will comprise of two papers i.e.

Paper	Test	No. of Questions	No. of Marks	Duration(in minutes)
Paper - I	Mental Ability Test(MAT)	100	100	120 minutes
Paper - II	Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)	100	100	120 minutes

There will be **No Negative Marking** in examination.

No Fees are charged for the Examination.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Student should have scored 60% or more marks in Class IXth exam held in March/April-2019
- 5% relaxation to SC/ST/PH candidates
- Students of Class Xth studying in recognized schools in Goa are eligible.

SYLLABUS :

Syllabus of Class IX & Class X

The Questions in MAT may be on Analogy, Classification, Hidden figures, Number Series, Pattern perception ,etc .where as in SAT covering the syllabus in Science, Mathematics and Social Science of Class IX and X .

Amount of Scholarship :

The amount of scholarship For National Talent Search Scheme will be as under :

- Scholarship of Rs.1250/- per month from Class XI to Class XII.
- Scholarship of Rs.2000/- per month for Undergraduates and Post graduates.
- Amount of Scholarship for Ph.D. is fixed in accordance with the UGC norms.

Reservation :

- 15% for students belonging to the **SC** category.
- 7.5% for students belonging to the **ST** category.
- 27% for students belonging to the **OBC** category (Non-creamy Layer)(as per central list)
- 10% for students belonging to Economical Weaker sections (EWSS)

- (e) 4% for **Physically Challenged** Group of Students with benchmark disabilities of which, one percent each shall be reserved for persons with benchmark disabilities under clauses (a), (b) and (c) and one percent for persons with benchmark disabilities under clauses (d) and (e) namely:
- (a) blindness and low vision: (BLV)
- (b) deaf and hard of hearing: (DH)
- (c) locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy: (LD)
- (d) autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness: (AID)
- (e) multiple disabilities from amongst persons under clauses (a) to (d) including deaf blindness in the posts identified for each disabilities (MD)

30 minutes compensatory time for candidates with benchmark disabilities will be allowed for writing exams.

Qualifying marks for General Category/OBC/EWS Candidates is **40% in each paper.**

Qualifying marks for SC/ST/PH Category Candidates is **32% in each paper.**

The seat numbers of candidates and venue of Examination will be intimated well in advance to the Headmaster/ Principal of the School/s through office of the A.D.E.I. of concerned taluka.

Candidates are advised to choose the centre of examination in the same Taluka where they are studying at present.

You are requested to give wide publicity to the Scheme of Scholarship Examination i.e. National Talent Search Scholarship Examination for the Students of Class X .

Head of the Institution is hereby requested to submit the applications of the eligible candidates for the State Level National Talent Search Examination (NTSE) 2019-20 in the prescribed proformas **on or before 30-08-2019** to the Director, State Council of Educational Research & Training, Alto-Porvorim, Goa.

Google form will be made available very soon. The schools have to open the Google form by using the URL which will be soon e-mailed to all the schools, fill the form and submit. The SCERT will generate the PDF of all the forms and e-mail the forms back to schools. The schools will take print of it, verify and certify the form and submit the hard copy to the Director, SCERT, Porvorim on or before 30-08-2019.

The photograph on application form as well as on Admission Card should be endorsed by the Head of the School.
