## Access and use Digital initiatives of NCERT under the aegis of MHRD-Govt. of India

**ePathshala for Digital Books and eContents:** Using ePathshala web portal and mobile app (Android, iOS, Windows) students, teachers, teacher educators and parents can access more than 600 digital books including 377 e-textbooks (classes I to XII) and 3500 audios and videos of NCERT for free in various languages (Hindi, English, Sanskrit and Urdu). **SWAYAM for Online Courses:** NCERT has launched 28 online courses for students (Classes XI & XII) and teachers on SWAYAM portal. Students and teachers can access all the course modules (text, videos and assessment questions) free by logging on to: *swayam.gov.in*

**NISHTHA:** National Initiatives for School Heads' and Teachers' Holistic Advancement (NISHTHA) is an integrated Teacher Training Portal and Mobile App (Android) created for capacity building programme of 42 lakhs Elementary School Teachers (Classes I to VIII). **NROER:** National Repository of Open Educational Resources (NROER) web portal is a store house of e-contents for students, teachers, teacher educators and parents. There are about 17,500 e-contents of NCERT and other collaborative partners available on NROER for free in various school subjects (Classes I to XII). **DIKSHA**: Digital Infrastructure for Knowledge Sharing (DIKSHA) portal and mobile app have been created by MHRD-Govt. of India. It is a store house of large number of e-books and econtents created by states/UTs and National level organizations including NCERT.
