Sub:- Organisation of Competitions under National Population Education Project.

Sir/Madam,

SCERT, Goa under National Population Education Project of NCERT, New Delhi is planning to organise the following competitions at (District / State Level) for the students of classes VIII and IX of Government High Schools of Goa.

1. Folk Dance Competition (Konkani)
2. Role Play Competition (English/Hindi/Konkani/Marathi)
3. Elocution Competition (English/Hindi/Konkani/Marathi)
4. Poster Competition

The Heads of the schools are requested to organise these competitions at their respective schools on the suggested themes. **Only one** winning performance (the best) in **each of these categories of competitions** may be forwarded to SCERT as entry for further adjudication for award at the District and State level. All entries selected for the District / State Level competition will be provided with participation certificates for students. The winners at District and State level Competition will get Cash Prizes as per the norms of NCERT.

Considering the Covid-19 Pandemic restrictions, the schools are requested to send the entries in electronic mode only in the form of Video clip of Folk Dance/Role Play/Elocution. Video clips of Folk Dance/Role Play should be limited to maximum of 6 minutes duration and the Video clip of Elocution should not exceed 3 minutes duration. Video clips of Folk Dance/Role Play/Elocution should be shoot with good picture quality with proper lighting and audio clarity. Professional editing, addition of

special effects etc. in the video is strictly prohibited. Entries for District level Poster Competition should be submitted to the office of SCERT, Porvorim. The original Poster with dimension of an A3 size paper should be submitted. No photocopy or print of the Poster will be acceptable.


All Entries of the above competition have to be submitted to the Director, SCERT, Porvorim, Goa, Email ID: scertgoa@gmail.com. The last date of submission of entries is **27th November 2021**. Entries should be submitted to SCERT with a brief report of the Competitions actually held in the school mentioning date, number of participants in each category etc.

The State Level competitions will be held at SCERT in **physical mode** where the winners of the winning entries at the District level will take part. The State level Competition is tentatively decided to be held in the first week of January 2022. The exact date will be intimated to the concerned schools in the due course of time.

Guidelines of organisation of different competitions along with the themes, marking scheme etc are attached herewith in "ANNEXURE - A".

You are therefore requested to organise the above competitions at school level and encourage your students to participate in the said competitions. Your whole hearted cooperation is highly solicited.

1. Folk Dance Competition (Konkani)

1. **Target Group** :- Class VIII/IX/students of both classes VIII & IX
2. **Time** :- 5-6 minutes
3. **Language** :- **Konkani** (Script of the song must be submitted)
4. **Number of participants** :- 4-6 students in a group
5. **Costumes** :- According to need of the dance on the selected theme.
6. **Number of entries** :- One from each school for District/State Level
7. **Criteria for Evaluation** :-

Points for judgement	Marks
a) Coverage of qualitative theme	25
b) Coverage of folk dance (Costume, rhythm and choreography)	30
c) Reflection of life skills during folkdance	40
d) Effectiveness of evaluation between folkdance & audience	05
Total	100

8. **Themes** :- (Any one theme may be selected for the competition)

- a) Equal opportunity for boys and girls
- b) Respect and care for elders
- c) Protection of environment
- d) Healthy relationships during adolescents.

9. **Instructions**:-

- i. The script must be submitted along with video clip.
- ii. Write the full name of Group Members along with the Class, Roll Number, Mobile Number, Name of school, Name and Contact Number of the Guiding/supervising teacher (who has to accompany the students for state level Competition)
- iii. A Certificate by the Head of the school must be attached, stating that the Group was the winner of the Folk Dance Competition held in the School.

2. Role Play Competition

1. **Target Group** :- Class IX
2. **Time** :- 5-6 minutes
3. **Language** :- English/Hindi/Konkani/Marathi
(Script must be submitted along with entries)
4. **Number of participants** :- 4-5 students
5. **Costumes** :- School dress
6. **Number of entries** :- One from each school for District/State Level
7. **Criteria for Evaluation** :-

b)	Presentation of Role play	25
c)	Reflection of life skills during Role play	40
d)	Effectiveness of evaluation between Role play & audience	10

 - a) Online Education
 - b) Personal safety (physical, mental, emotional and sexual)
 - c) Safe use of internet and gadgets
 - d) Substance abuse prevention.

- ii. Write the full name of Group Members along with the Class, Roll Number, Mobile Number, Name of school, Name and Contact Number of the Guiding/supervising teacher (who has to accompany the students for state level Competition)
- iii. A Certificate by the Head of the school must be attached, stating that the Group was the winner of the Role Play Competition held in the School.

3. Elocution Competition

1. **Target Group** :- Class VIII or IX
2. **Time** :- 3 minutes
3. **Language** :- English/Hindi/Konkani/Marathi
(Script must be submitted along with entries)
4. **Number of Entry** :- 1 from each school for District/State Level
5. **Criteria for Evaluation** :-

a) Content	20
b) Delivery	10
c) Poise	10
d) Overall Impression	10

6. **Theme** :- (Any one theme has to select for the competition)
 - a) Substance Abuse
 - b) Protection of Environment
 - c) Online Education

7. Instructions:-

- i. The script has to be submitted along with video clip.
- ii. Write the full name, school name, Roll Number, standard, Contact Mobile Number on the script.
- iii. A Certificate by the Head of the school to be attached, stating that the student was the winner of the Elocution Competition held in the School.

4. Poster Competition

2. **Number of Entries** :- 1 from each school for District/State Level
3. **Size of Poster** :- A- 3 size Paper
4. **Material** :- Water colour
