1. Provide daily questions, weekly practice questions and mock test papers with answer key.
2. Provide continual support through sharing effective teaching micro-practices through WhatsApp channels and VSK website

Role of School Heads:

Supervise the daily questions and weekly practices by the respective teachers through classroom rounds, post activity debriefs and progress charts.

Role of Teachers:

Ensure that the daily questions and weekly practices are conducted to nudge students to think. Teachers must ask questions to individual students, motivate students to reply and refrain from telling answers till the end.

2. Suggest good practices they do in their classrooms so that other schools can benefit.
