### **GUIDELINES FOR CONDUCTING EXTERNAL PRACTICAL EXAMINATION OF SKILL BASED SUBJECTS FOR GRADE 3 AND GRADE 6**

Skill-based Subjects for

Grade 3: Art Education & Physical Education

Grade 6: Art Education, Physical Education and Vocational Education

Schools are required to adhere to the following given Instructions for Conducting Practical Examinations in Skill-Based Subjects (Grade 3 & Grade 6):

1. No Written Examination  
There will be no written examination for skill-based subjects. Only a practical assessment will be conducted as the external component
2. External Examiner Requirement  
The practical examination must be conducted in the presence of an External Examiner
3. Eligibility of External Examiner  
A teacher teaching the respective skill-based subject in Grade 3 or Grade 6 in any of the following institutions may act as an External Examiner:
  - a. Government Schools
  - b. Government Aided Schools
  - c. Unaided Recognised Schools
4. Responsibility of Schools  
The schools must independently arrange for an External Examiner while conducting the practical component of skill-based subjects.
5. Schedule of Examination  
The practical examination for the First Semester is to be conducted in the month of September 2025.
6. Nature of Activities  
All practical activities conducted as part of the examination must be individual-based. Group activities are not permitted.
7. Documentation and Verification  
The signature of the External Examiner must be obtained on all marksheets related to the practical examination of skill-based subjects.

#### **Grade 3**

##### **1) Art Education**

- Semester 1 Practical will have a weightage of 20 mark.
- Any two activities out of the given four are to be considered for Practical.
  - I. Any one activity based on Visual Arts mapped to the CG aligned competencies similar to the activities listed in the textbook. (10 Mark)
  - II. Any one activity from the Music Component of the textbook or any other similar activity mapped to the CG aligned competencies. (10 Mark)
  - III. Any one activity from the Dance & Movement Component of the textbook or any other similar activity mapped to the CG aligned competencies. (10 Mark)
  - IV. Any one activity based on Theatre mapped to the CG aligned competencies similar to the activities listed in the textbook. (10 Mark)



## 2) Physical Education

- Semester 1 Practical will have a weightage of 20 mark.
- Both the given activities are to be considered for Practical.
  - i. Any one skill of the students is to be considered for Practical examination from unit number 1: Throwing and Catching mapped to the CG aligned competencies similar to the activities listed in the textbook. (10 Marks)
  - ii. Any one activity from the unit 3 – Yoga mapped to the CG aligned competencies similar to the activities listed in the textbook. (10 Marks)

## Grade 6

### 1) Art Education

- Semester 1 Practical will have a weightage of 40 mark.
- Any two activities out of the given four are to be considered for Practical.
  - i. Any one activity based on Visual Arts mapped to the CG aligned competencies similar to the activities listed in the textbook. (20 Marks)
  - ii. Any one activity from the Music Component of the textbook or any other similar activity mapped to the CG aligned competencies. (20 Marks)
  - iii. Any 10 Hastamudras or Performing any one Indian Classical dance. (20 Marks)
  - iv. Any one activity based on Theatre mapped to the CG aligned competencies similar to the activities listed in the textbook. (20 Marks)

### 2) Physical Education for Grade 6

- Semester 1 Practical will have a weightage of 40 mark.
- Any two activities out of the given three are to be considered for Practical.
  - i. Any two skills of the students are to be considered for Practical examination from unit number 3: Fundamental Skills of Kho-Kho. (20marks)
  - ii. Nadishuddhi Pranayama or Pranayama is to be considered for the Practical Examination (20 Marks)
  - iii. Any two Asanas from the Chapter 3 of Yoga (20 Marks)

### 3) Vocational Education

- Semester 1 Practical will have a weightage of 40 mark.
- Both the activities given below are to be considered for Practical.
  - i. Any 1 Activity from Part 1: Work with Life Forms mapped to the CG aligned competencies similar to the activities listed in the textbook. (20 Marks)
  - ii. Any 1 Activity from Part 3: Work in Human Services, mapped to the CG aligned competencies similar to the activities listed in the textbook. (20 Marks)



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
