
1. Title of the Programme

2. Themes of the Competition


4. Objectives

- To provide a platform for students to express their thoughts and ideas through visual art.

6. Nature of the Competition

- Mode: **Online / Digital Submission**
- Type: **Individual Participation**
- Each participant can submit **only one digital poster** under any one theme.

7. Guidelines for Poster Preparation

- First participate in Pariksha Pe Charcha 2026 online Multiple-Choice Question (MCQ) competition being conducted at Government Official PPC Portal <https://innovateindia1.mygov.in> from **1st December 2025 to 11th January 2026**
- Posters must be **original** and created by the student.
- The content should be relevant to the chosen theme and convey a clear message.
- Use of slogans, quotes, and short captions is encouraged.
- Posters should be visually appealing, neat, and readable.
- Language: **English / Hindi / Konkani** (any one).
- File Format: **JPEG / PNG / PDF**
- Recommended Size: **A4 (Digital)** or equivalent resolution.
